Thank you for volunteering to be the team parent/captain for your child's tennis team!

Responsibilities:

- ♦ Familiarize yourself with the USTA Colorado JTT Regulations. Available on <u>ustacolorado.com</u>.
- Ask Facility Coordinator for an email and phone list for every player on your team.
- ♦ Email or call each player, get his/her vacation schedule and mark those days on the schedule. Then mix and match the kids so that they get close to the same number of matches for the season. A player may play a singles match <u>OR</u> a doubles match in one team match, not both. Substitutions may be used in both singles and doubles. Ask your facility coordinator if this applies for your team.
- ♦ Match schedules and standings are available online at <u>ustacolorado.com</u>. Note: The standings on TennisLink are often not accurate.
- ♦ Set up a driving schedule for the away matches and a drink and snack schedule for the home matches.
- ♦ On the <u>Thursday before the match</u>, team coach/captains should call the opposing team coach/captain if there are any issues for the upcoming match, such as insufficient number of players.
- Players must be at match location at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
- After each match the <u>scorecard should be filled out and signed by each team</u> <u>parent</u>. Take a picture of the completed scorecard and text it to your facility coordinator.
- Facility Coordinators or assigned team captains are to enter scores within 48 hours. It is the responsibility of both teams to enter the scores on TennisLink. Scores that are not entered within 3 weeks or by the score entry deadline will be input as double defaults.
- ♦ Teams that finish in 1st place must submit a "Playoff Confirmation form" by July 24.
- State Championships will be held for qualifying teams on August 2-4, 2024.

Things to Remember:

- Notify opposing team of any club/facility particulars.
- ♦ An adult must supervise all team matches to ensure the lineups are exchanged and the correct players are sent to the correct courts.
- Your team should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to match time. Earlier is better.
- Practice and promote good sportsmanship.
- ♦ NO COACHING IS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.
- ♦ Sign the scorecards to verify scores. Take a picture of completed scorecards and text it to your Facility Coordinator. Keep all scorecards on file until the end of the season.
- ♦ Regularly check team standings on <u>ustacolorado.com</u> to ensure that all match scores have been entered correctly.
- ♦ Help make this a fun experience for the players!
